Anna Maksymova – biography

Originally from Ukraine, Anna Maksymova started piano at the Donetsk Music School for gifted children with Irina Zalevskaya. In New Zealand she studied with Peter Nagy, Judith Clark and Dr Gao Ping. Anna has participated successfully local competitions such as Christchurch Competitions, Pacanz National Young Performer of the Year and New Zealand Secondary Schools Chamber Competition. Currently Anna is doing Bachelor of Music with Honours at the University of Canterbury with Professor Michael Endres.

For the past two years Anna has performed in the “Outstanding Young Musicians in Concert” series in Christchurch. In 2010 Anna was the winner of the Lewis Eady Charitable Trust Emerging Artist Series. Last year he was a semi-finalist at Lev Vlassenko National Competition in Brisbane, Australia, and the finalist in Indonesia Pusaka International Piano Competition. Anna is also the recipient of the Ruby Hay Scholarship, Pettman Special Programme Scholarship 2011 and Leslie Atkinson Memorial Prize in Music. This year Anna is a 3rd prize winner at the Kerikeri International Piano Competition.
